**9:00 WALKING TOUR OF OLD MONTRÉAL**

First this easy and relaxed walking tour will bring you into our **Underground City** conveniently located between the Business District and Old Montréal. After a short transfer by metro, you will discover the **Quartier International de Montréal (QIM)**, a new sector of Montréal featuring arts, urban architecture and world-class design. The QIM is built around major points of interests as the **Place Jean-Paul-Riopelle** and its fountain sculpture La Joute.

Across from the Place is the **World Trade Center**, a transition toward Old Montréal, at the heart of the birthplace of Montréal. A stroll through a maze of narrow lanes and old buildings provides a perfect opportunity to discover **Old Montréal's history and charm**. With their dazzling display of architecture, the streets and buildings testify to Montréal's rich heritage and illustrate a period of its history. The tour will feature a number of remarkable restorations that have breathed new life into **the Old Port** and includes the visit of majestic **Notre-Dame Basilica**, a remarkable example of neo-gothic architecture. In this historic part of the city, Ville Marie was built in **1642**.

MAY 4 — TUESDAY

**9:00 MONTRÉAL, C'EST MAGNIFIQUE**

Discover Montréal with its bicultural heritage and cosmopolitan blend of the old and new on this comprehensive overview of our city. We will introduce you **to various parts of the city** that make Montréal what it is today. You will have the chance to see how culturally diverse Montréal is and the rich architecture and historical legacy. Along the way, the tour includes a stop at the summit of **Mount Royal Park** for a **panoramic view of the city**.

You will visit the second largest **Botanical Garden** in the world with a coverage of 73 acres displaying 26,000 species of flowers and plants in **30 outdoor gardens and 10 greenhouses**. Of special interest: a remarkable collection of bonsai and orchids. You can choose to visit the Exhibition Greenhouses, the Japanese Pavilion, the Chinese Garden, the Arboretum or the Insectarium. It is the green jewel of Montréal.
