

• 163 participants joined the webinar across Canada and represented various organizations.



POLL #1: REGULATORY BARRIERS TO INNOVATION PROJECT PROPOSALS APPROVAL

- I. Changes in costs and technology are occurring faster than rate case cycles.
- 2. Uncertainties and risks around new technologies and operating practices.
- 3. Traditional benefit-cost tests have limitations in valuing the externalities related to achieving public policy objectives as a benefit.
- 4. More support required for navigating the complex regulatory and policy landscape.
- 5. Other.

POLL#2: CURRENT LEVEL OF KNOWLEDGE RELATED TO INNOVATION IN CANADA'S ELECTRICITY SECTOR

- 40% of participants do not have a good understanding of federal programs supporting electricity innovation in Canada.
- 36% of participants understand how economic regulation works in their jurisdiction, but less of other jurisdictions in Canada.
- 16% of participants has a good understanding of innovation at the project level, but less of how economic regulation works.
